LETTER FROM THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

Dear Friends,

In 2022, with the help of more than 5,000 volunteers, we harvested 224,635 pounds (or more than 600,000 servings) of produce between our Northside and Powhatan farms. From May to November, we held 15 Mobile Markets per week, reached almost 2,000 direct customers, and distributed fresh produce to a dozen organizational partners reaching over 8000 more. Our Produce Rx program, working in concert with our clinical partners, created regular opportunities for people to invest in their overall wellbeing. Our Food Skills Classes brought people together to share skills, recipes, and time-saving preparation of healthy meals.

We grew excellent produce and we made sure it was easy to find, easy to use and easy to eat. We know this is table stakes in the work toward a more equitable food system, but we are so grateful to be at this place with you.

So in 2023, we are eager and excited to do more. We kick off the year with a new three year strategic plan which includes an even deeper investment in our city, in our partnerships and in our impact. I am personally looking forward to meeting each and every one of you, and exploring closer connections, productive collaborations, and resilient solutions.

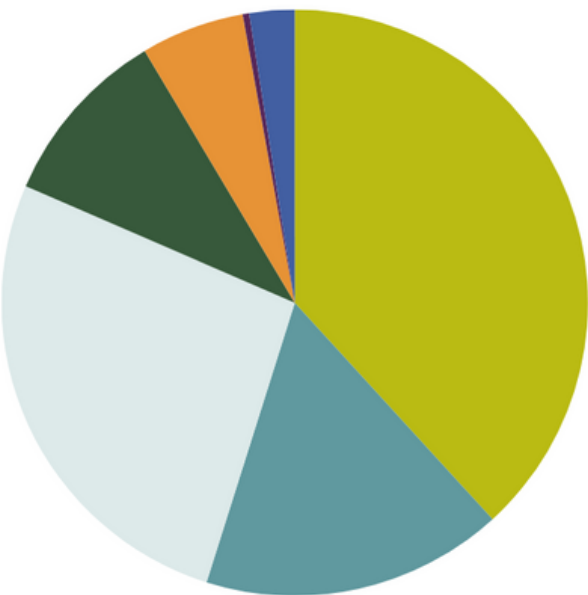

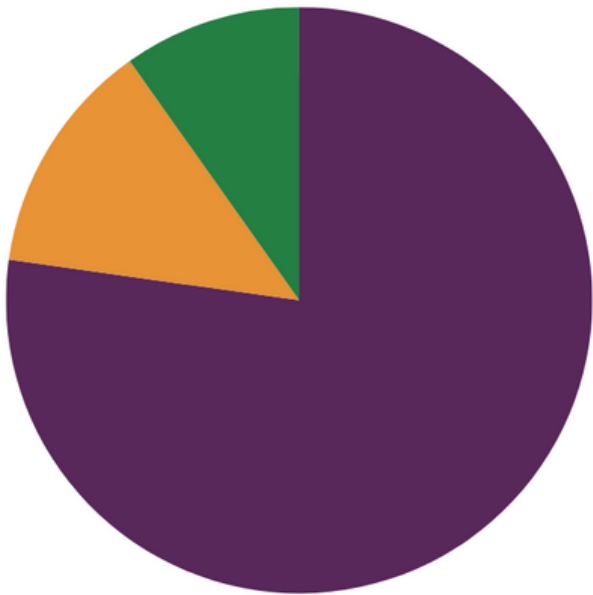

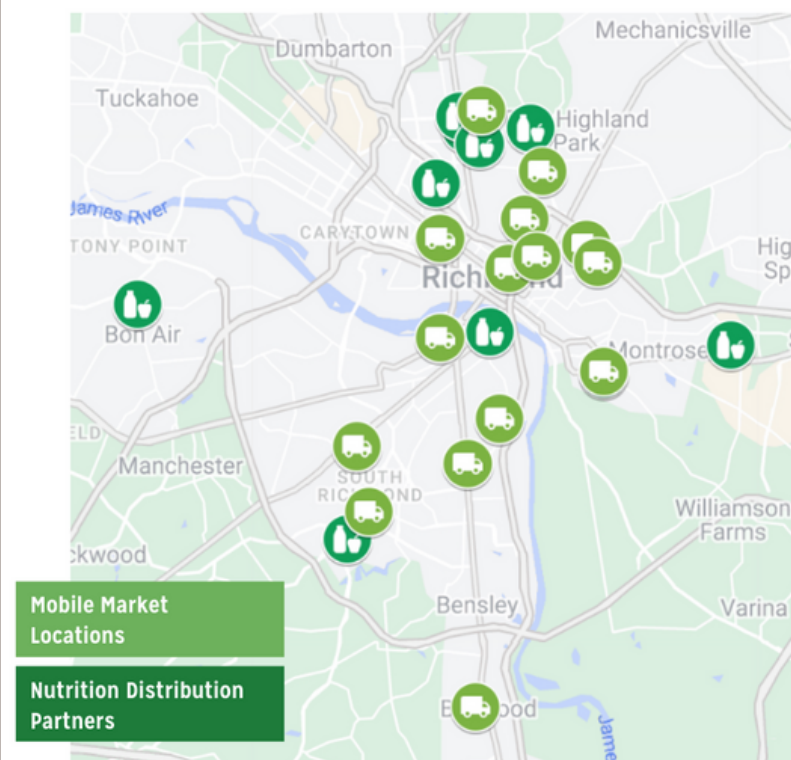

Ms. B said that the Produce Rx Program helped her to eat like she wants to eat. The focus on goal setting has helped her improve her blood pressure and she has been able to come off of her blood pressure medicine. She said living alone on a limited budget makes it hard to focus on healthy choices. PRx helped her figure out how to add more vegetables into her life.

Ms. S stated that she appreciated the Produce Rx Program because it helped her to focus on her diabetes. She is working to decrease her A1C and it has helped her to set goals. She added vegetables to every meal and in doing so, cut back on unhealthy carbs. She lives alone and didn't need all the vegetables each week, so she dried some and stored them for snacks or adding to soups in the winter.

I loved that the class allowed us to sample what we cooked and to take home a sample to share with the family along with the recipe. This way we could get immediate feedback and we were free to experiment with the recipe to fit our families taste buds.

POWHATAN FARM

Major Projects @ Powhatan

Support from more than 150 CarMax volunteers allowed us to make critical upgrades to our green house and coolers, harvest garlic, onions, and build a curing station.



Major Projects @ Northside

Support provided by Tito's Block to Block program enabled us to expand our Northside Farm - a major infrastructure improvement, which added more than 3,000 additional feet of growing space.



Support provided by Virginia Credit Union enabled us to prepare our garlic crop for planting, put summer fields to rest for the winter, and built new tables for our greenhouse.
