Shalom Farms' Shared Use Requirements

We look forward to sharing our space with you! In order to ensure the safety of those in your group or participating in your program, as well as ensure the safety of our crops and respectful use of our farms, we ask that you please read the following list of instructions carefully.

Use of Space:

You are welcome to move throughout the farm on designated pathways and in outdoor classroom and meeting spaces. As a general rule, if a door is closed, please don't open it without explicit permission or assistance from a staff member. We do not allow access to the following areas:

- The Greenhouse and hoophouse
- Walk-in coolers
- Studio office
- Shipping containers
- Cover cropped or covered field space (unless express permission was given during a site visit)

Use of furniture, Equipment and Materials:

- Tables can be moved and used as long as they're moved back
- Shelves should not be moved or have items moved off of them.
- Hot and cold water can be accessed upon request.
- Porta potties and hand sanitizer are available as needed.
- Electricity/outlets are available upon request (potentially for a fee to cover utility costs)
- Trash/recycling is carry-out. Recycling dumpster can be used upon exit of the space, but trash must be taken off-site.
- Compost needs to be well sorted, follow our listed guidelines and left in a specific bin and location for staff.
- Access to the outdoor kitchen and kitchen equipment is not available.

Use of Parking Area:

- Group organizers/leaders can drive up to the barn to unload program materials, but then must park in the visitor lot.
- All guests should park in the visitor lot.

General Farm Rules:

- The use of tobacco, vape products, alcohol and drugs is prohibited.
- Picking crops is prohibited.
- Keep a safe distance from our beehives at all times.
- Use of farm vehicles and farm equipment is prohibited. This includes sitting or standing on farm vehicles and equipment.
- Guests are responsible for providing their own first aid kit.
- Dogs are not allowed inside the fenced areas where our crops are growing
- Guests may not cut through fields or planted rows. Please follow designated pathways at all times
